

TRINITY ADMISSIONS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



What are the steps in the Admissions Process?

The first step is to learn about the school by attending Open House or touring the school. Once you have decided Trinity is the place for you, you can complete the Application for Admission. Applications will open for new families on February 3, 2020. You should apply early for the best chance of securing a spot in your child's grade. Once you have submitted the application, the school will contact you to schedule a time for your child to shadow at the school and go through a preliminary academic assessment. The school will contact you regarding a decision within one to two weeks of the assessment.

How do I submit an Application for Admission?

Open Enrollment for new families will begin on February 3, 2020. At that time, the application will be available on our website (<http://www.tesvictoria.org/enroll/apply.cfm>). You will need to be on a computer to submit the application. The system will not work with a smart phone or iPad. You will need to create a username and login in order to apply. Once you have submitted your application, you should receive a confirmation email. If you do not, please contact the Admissions Office.

What supplemental materials do you require as part of the Admissions Application?

The supplemental materials vary by grade and include: letters of recommendation, teacher evaluations, record request permission forms, and immunization records.

Do you offer Financial Assistance?

We understand that it can be a financial sacrifice to provide the very best education for your child. We do offer need-based financial aid to many families. Information about the FAST financial aid application can be found in your packet or on our website.

What is the best way to check on the status of my application?

What happens if there is not an opening in my child's grade?

Even if enrollment is full in a certain grade, there is always a chance that a spot will open due to unforeseen circumstances. We encourage you to apply, assess, and submit all of your supplemental materials so that you can be placed on our interest list.

What does Rolling Admissions mean?

While the bulk of our enrollment takes place in the spring, we do accept applications for the current year on a rolling basis. As long as we have openings in your grade, any time is a great time to make the transition to Trinity.
